

ELLIS COUNTY AGGIE MOMS CLUB 2019-20 SCHOLARSHIP

Biography

The Federation of Texas A&M University Mothers' Clubs was organized in 1928 and has grown to include 109 individual Member Clubs located across Texas and throughout the nation. The mission of our organization is "by individual and united effort to contribute in every way to the comfort and welfare of the students and to cooperate with Texas A&M University in maintaining a high standard of moral conduct and intellectual attainment". Texas A&M University Mothers' Clubs are proud organizations, proud of Texas A&M and proud of the daughters and sons they send to Texas A&M University and into the future of the Great State of Texas.

Purpose and Eligibility

This scholarship is set up to provide financial resources to incoming freshman or returning Aggies for the purpose of completing their education at Texas A&M University. Seniors graduating the spring of the selection year are not eligible.

Amount and Duration of Scholarship

The number of scholarships and the amounts of scholarship awards will be at the discretion of the ECAM board each year. At a minimum, it is desirable to award at least two scholarships per academic school year. Awards will be distributed ½ per semester and deposited in the student account at TAMU. The spring of 2019 award amount will be (3) \$1,000 scholarships. The scholarship is for one year and is a one-time award for each recipient upon verification of enrollment and attendance at Texas A&M University.

Application Deadline

Applications are available on our Webpage <https://elliscounty.aggie moms.org/> or thru Ellis County High School counselors. Applications must be postmarked by **April 1, 2019**

Criteria for Selection

The recipient must be a newly accepted freshman or a returning student at Texas A&M University. A minimum of a 2.5 GPA for returning students and a 2.5 on a 4.0 high school scale are required to be considered. Eligible candidates will have a permanent address on file at Texas A&M that is within Ellis County Texas. Prior recipients of this scholarship are not eligible.

Selection Rubric

The recipient must be a newly accepted freshman or a returning student at Texas A&M University. The student must reside in Ellis County, Texas.

| • Extra Curricular (multiple questions) | 40% |
| • Essay | 20% |
